











Diaper Changing Steps

1. Check to see if all of your supplies are ready and put gloves on.
 2. Lay child on table. Never leave child unattended.
 3. Clean child's bottom from front to back.
 4. Put disposable diaper in a lined, covered trash can.
 5. Remove soiled gloves and put in a lined, covered trash can.
 6. Use disposable wipes to clean your hands and another clean wipe to clean the child's hands.
 7. Diaper and dress the child.
 8. Wash the child's hands with liquid soap and warm water for 20 seconds.
 9. Return the child to a supervised area.
 10. Clean with soap and water: the diaper changing surface and any toys or objects touched during the diaper change.
 11. Sanitize the same area with a bleach and water solution. Allow the solution to dry two minutes before wiping up.
 12. Wash your hands with warm, running water and soap
