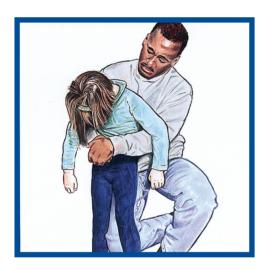
## Child Choking (Approximately 1 to 8 years)





## Recognize choking:

- Choking sign
- Cannot cry, cough, or speak forcefully
- Breathing with high-pitched noises
- Blue lips or skin



- Ask "Are you choking?" If yes, tell the child you are going to help
- Give abdominal thrusts until
  - Object comes out

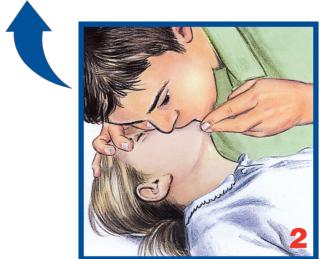
Child can breathe and make sounds

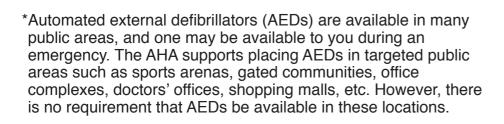
or

Child stops responding



- If the child stops responding
  - Begin steps of CPR
  - Each time you open the airway, look for the object (remove it if seen)
  - After 5 cycles, phone 911 and get AED\* (if available)
  - Resume CPR
