The danger in your purse could be harmful, or even fatal.



May irritate eyes if aimed improperly

Hand sanitizer:

Contains alcohol so swallowing large amounts could result in feeling drunk; may irritate eyes, skin and mouth

Nail polish remover:

May irritate eyes, skin and mouth, or upset stomach if swallowed

Insect

repellent: May irritate eyes and mouth; possible seizures if swallowed

Eye drops:

May cause a variety of mild to serious symptoms if swallowed

Prescription medicines:

May cause a wide variety of minor to serious problems, depending on product

Over-the-counter cold medicine:

May cause agitation, jitters, drowsiness

Nose spray:

May cause extreme drowsiness or agitation if swallowed

May irritate

eyes, skin or upset

Toothpaste:

May cause if swallowed

problems

Pepper spray:

May irritate eyes and skin or cause breathing problems

Cigarettes:

baby powder

May cause severe stomach upset and vomiting if swallowed

May cause eye and mouth irritation

Batteries: Ink pen:

May cause severe irritation or burns if chewed; also a choking hazard
